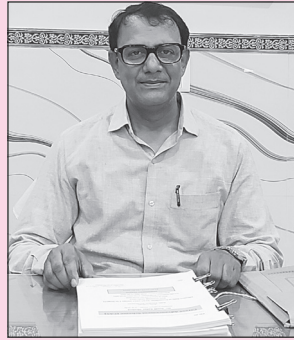

## The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The IQAC of the college plays a vital role in promoting quality enhancement and sustenance in academic and administrative activities. Established in accordance with the guidelines of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council, the IQAC functions as a catalyst for continuous improvement and institutional development.

The IQAC regularly undertakes initiatives related to academic excellence, innovative teaching-learning methods, faculty development, student support services, research promotion, extension activities and the effective use of ICT in education. It organizes seminars, workshops, awareness programmes and feedback mechanisms involving students, teachers and other stakeholders to ensure quality-oriented governance.

After successfully securing accreditation in the first cycle by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Kulti College is presently undertaking extensive preparations for the second cycle of NAAC accreditation to further enhance institutional quality and academic excellence.

## NSS at Kulti College

The National Service Scheme (NSS) at Kulti College plays a vital role in promoting community development and social responsibility among students. Guided by the motto 'Not Me, But You', the college runs two active NSS units with over 50 dedicated volunteers engaged in regular social service activities. Their initiatives include maintaining a green and clean campus, organising blood donation camps, health awareness rallies and tree plantation drives. During Students' Week, NSS volunteers conduct seminars, workshops and cultural programmes focused on youth empowerment and social awareness. The annual Special Camp in adopted villages remains a major highlight, where volunteers participate in health check-ups, educational outreach and Shramdaan activities to improve local infrastructure. Through these efforts, NSS nurtures leadership, empathy, and civic responsibility among students.

Speaking of extra curricular activities, the words of Swami Vivekananda rings in the ears – "They alone live, who live for others, the rest are more dead than alive". The foundation of the NSS lies in these words. The college has a vibrant and active team of NSS volunteers who do justice to the very spirit of NSS. Their activities include:

- Special Camp that undertakes visits to an adopted village for Social Service activities ranging from tree plantation, cleanliness drives to awareness programs.
- Celebration of International Yoga Day.
- Thalassemia awareness program organized in collaboration with Lions' Club, Neamatpur.

## NCC at Kulti College

Kulti College has had an NCC unit since 2011. It is under the 10th Bengal Battalion. Our primary goal through this NCC unit is to foster unity and discipline among the cadets, and to train them to fulfil their responsibilities as true citizens of the country and society. Perhaps this is why most of the NCC cadets who graduated from our college are currently serving the nation.

## BEYOND ACADEMICS

While the college strives to provide quality education, empowering students with skills that will assist them to build a career, we at Kulti College also realize that the institution, which some would like to consider as their second home, has a meaning beyond it. We envision a place where students would discover or rediscover their passion in activities that extend beyond the prescribed curriculum. Putting it in fancy words “Grades teach us knowledge while extracurricular activities teach us life.” A person thrives in a profession where she or he has as innate passion in. We just help them discover it. Morgan Freeman, the five time Academy Award nominee and the winner of the Academy Award for his role as Eddie “Scrap-Iron” Dupris in Million Dollar Baby (2004), believed that he began to settle into school because he had discovered the extracurricular activities that interested him: music and theater. Extracurricular activities thus bind students to this institution.

**(a) Sports:** The College has a dedicated committee that in collaboration with the student body organizes an Annual Sports Event. The events span from 100m sprint, 400m relay to long-jump and high jump. Several participants from across disciplines perform well at these events. This provides a stepping stone for them into competitive athletics. It is worth mentioning that one of our students, Sristi Das, went on to secure 2nd position in 800m run and 3rd position 400m run at the Inter College sports meet held at Raniganj Girls’ College on January 27th , 2026.

**(b) Cultural Events Awareness Programs:** Putting on a earphone some run with it, some dance to its tunes. while some just sing along with it. Such are humans, with diverse passions. We at Kulti College realize this and try to provide ample opportunities for the students to perform at Cultural Events as well. Notable among these are,

- Quiz competition and Enactment of drama, based on “Thakur ka kuaan” by Premchand, organized by the Hindi Department on the occasion of “Vishwa Hindi Diwas”.
- Wall Magazine and Debate Competition on the occasion of “Human Rights Day”.
- Annual cultural competition (2025-26) was held on 20th-21st May, 2026

- Debate Competition on Human Rights organized by the Department of Political

- Screening of Jane Austen's "Pride and Prejudice" by the Department of English.
- Celebration of International Mother Tongue Day by the Department of Bengali.

- Awareness program on cyber crime organized by the Internal Complaints Cell, Kulti College.

These set the stage for wider recognition beyond the college and sometimes beyond the country.

**(d) Kulti College Alumni:** Anuparna Roy won the Best Director Award in the Orizzonti (Horizons) section at the 82nd Venice International Film Festival in 2025 for her debut feature film 'Songs of Forgotten Trees'. It is a matter of great pride for us that she hails from the English Department of Kulti College.

These include Invited Lectures and Field Trips that provide hands on experience or puts the already gained knowledge into perspective.

## Administrative and Academic Audit

A team from Kazi Nazrul University visited our college on February 3, 2026, to assess the academic and administrative standard of the institution, based on such parameters as faculty-student ratio, college infrastructure, quality of teaching-learning and continuous evaluation processes, laboratory and library facility, accomplishments in the field of research and publication, experiential and participative learning, scholarships awarded to students, outstanding performance of current students and alumni in the fields of culture and sports, job placements, NSS activities, students' feedback and service rendered by office staff. Having pointed out a few areas with scope for improvement, the university team was satisfied with the college's overall performance.



## The Academic Calendar

The academic calendar of Kulti College serves as a structured roadmap that ensures the smooth and efficient functioning of the institution's academic and co-curricular activities. It systematically outlines the schedule of classes, examinations, holidays, and important events, thereby helping students and faculty plan their time effectively. By maintaining transparency and discipline, the calendar promotes regularity in teaching-learning processes and timely completion of the syllabus. It also integrates extracurricular, cultural, and institutional activities, contributing to the holistic development of students. The academic calendar of Kulti College reflects the college's commitment to organized education, academic excellence, and a balanced campus life.

## COLLEGE LIBRARY

- Kulti College provides an extensive range of information services through the Library Department to support Class room learning and enable students to study more effectively.
- The Library Department supports automated library operations, and Library Users are able to search their requisition through dedicated Computers.
- Apart from the textbooks, the Library has a number of reference books on every subject. Besides catering to the formal needs of the students, the Library can provide ample opportunities to those who intend to carry on higher research in some subjects. Along with books, the library purchases and subscribes to a large number of periodicals of both popular and specialized in nature, newspapers in Bengali, English and Hindi. Students are encouraged to make full use of and take advantage of the College Library.
- The Library Reading Room section affords facilities for a quiet and peaceful environment for self-study. Students are allowed to take multiple books and periodicals for real-time study in the reading room upon producing a valid library card and are allowed to take advantage of this section for the whole day.
- The students are permitted to take out books for study through the home issue facility. For this purpose, students have to enrol in the Library Department just after getting admission. Notices regarding all information are regularly shared in the departmental Notice Board, College Notice Board and College Websites also.
- It is mandatory that books issued from the Library as Home Issue be returned or renewed within the stipulated time as framed by the competent authority from time to time. Otherwise, a late fine and penalty will be imposed as per the decision of the authority. Books issued for Reading Room purposes are not meant for home use. It is punishable if not be returned within the day.

Students can access the bibliographic data of library holdings through the SOUL software. For this purpose, a short-term training will be provided to all newcomers completely free of cost immediately after enrollment. There is a number of dedicated computers for all users with high-speed internet connectivity for accessing the internet free of cost, only for academic purposes.

## (b) Loss of Library Cards

Loss of Library cards or books should be immediately reported to the Library Department in writing, duly forwarded by the Principal and through the proper intimation & necessary action to the local Police Station. Verbal information will not be entertained.

For a New Library card after loss or damage, students have to deposit Rs 25/- as a penalty and all other requisites for each new card, but for only one time. A library clearance certificate is mandatory for each student before the University Examination form fill-up, as well as before college leaving.



## Internal Complaint Committee (ICC)

An Internal Complaints Committee was constituted in Kulti College to ensure gender sensitivity and prevention of sexual harassment in the workplace. It was constituted as per the UGC (Prevention, Prohibition and Remedies of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in Institutions of Higher Education (Regulations 2015 and 2022). The main objective was to create sensitivity and awareness on gender justice among the academic and non-academic community of this educational institution.

#### **Measures for Prohibition of Ragging at the Institution Level:-**

The institute shall strictly observe the provisions of the Act of the Central Government and the State Governments if any, or if enacted, considering ragging as a cognizable offence under the law on a par with rape and other atrocities against women and ill-treatment of the persons belonging to the SC/ST, and prohibiting ragging in all its forms in all institutions.

Ragging in all its forms shall be totally banned in the entire institution, including its departments, constituent units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen, etc.) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private.

The institution shall take strict action against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging.

#### **Punishments at the Institution Level :-**

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following :-

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Cancellation of admission
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period
- Fine ranging between Rupees 25,000/- and Rupees 1 lakh
- Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment
